YOUR PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

Variety and hybrid breeding.

As barley breeder at Nordic Seed Germany you will contribute to the development of new varieties and hybrids in winter barley. You will perform scoring, observation, evaluation and selection in breeding and screening trials in close cooperation with head of barley breeder in Denmark. You record, process and analyze breeding and screening data including genomic selection and GWAS provided by our molecular breeder and genomic breeder. In addition, you will be involved in project collaborations with academia and universities, managing practical project activities in this respect. The position is part of the Breeding team at Nordic Seed consisting of experienced breeders, genomic breeders, molecular breeder, assistant breeders and technicians.

- Plan, prepare and execute field trials. This involves, for example:
 - Design of trials and field layouts
 - Preparation of seed for sowing
 - Conducting maintenance breeding
- Plan and coordinate crossing plan with the head of barley breeder
- Perform phenotypic scorings and selections in breeding trials and breeding gardens
- Perform statistical data analysis from field data
- Employing genomic selection in early generation
- Active participation of speed breeding

- Maintain field books and data recording
- Contact with academia and universities in project collaborations
